He also runs a summer camp at Sac State targeting Youth for Christ members and other lower income programs.

SATA Community Projects include supporting area high school tennis teams in low income areas. Seasons are complete but we are always looking for donations of balls, rackets, bags & shoes.

Four Grand Prix tournaments are completed with one scheduled for each of the next three weekends. There were 130 players at Gold River. Folsom Lake College is to sign up for another tournament.
