

SATA Board Meeting Synopsis

September 13, 2016

Community Projects:

The 2016 Spring season was completed spending \$1,630.51 including the purchase of seven nets for Florin High School that are now in use. So far in the Fall we've spent \$943.43 which does not include eight nets for Valley High School. Donations this year total \$2,501 including an anonymous donation of \$1,000. The new girls coach at Rio Linda is working out well. This school year will be Paula's last year chairing the community projects committee so please let any SATA Board member know if you are interested in the SATA Community Projects program.

Interclub leagues:

The fall interclub season is going well with 27 leagues and 146 teams; the online player registration went smoothly. There will be no Winter Flex league this year due to lack of interest which will allow a lengthening of the Spring league.

Online services:

Online registration for the junior tournaments has been going well with additional functionality in progress. Online registration for club renewal is in process and should be complete for club renewals that start in November. Club membership will be \$80 which helps cover processing fees and web maintenance costs.

Honoring our captains:

SATA would not be what it is without the work of our team captains who we want to recognize. To honor our captains SATA will award Captain Pins to our 191 captains in 2016. 28 captains have captained more than 20 times in the last 8 years and the top "Super Captains", four who captained over teams, will be invited to the November SATA meeting for presentation of their Captain Pins.
